They continue to need foster homes for the rescued dogs. They are using Craig's List for this all over the state. They want to set up a way for people to donate to the group by using Pay Pal. There are many steps involved in making the newly renamed rescue group separate from GCWC. All of these efforts for this are ongoing.

Mary Ann Hall, Secretary of the Hunt Tests, and Elena Lamberson, Secretary of the Specialty Shows, led the group at the meeting discussing entries to these events and going over details, including assigning club members to duties, for the Hunt Trials on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday (January 14,15,16) and the Specialty Show on Friday, January 28.

In New Business, the club needs buy bird equipment and order more birds.
