Treasurer Report - Jeannette Myers. Our mutual funds have grown by \$737. Checking Acct balance is \$8670. Cindy Simmons of Weim Rescue of SC sent a check for \$86 from donations at Bark To The Park in April.

Rescue Report - Elena Lamberson

We continue to make slow but steady strides in separating the Weimaraner Rescue of SC from GCWC. Linda Garrett is going to help us with the paperwork to apply to incorporate as a non profit & apply for 501c3 status with the IRS. After this is accomplished, we will open our own bank account, begin fund raising and find separate insurance coverage. We have a good network of volunteers all over SC and neighboring states. Cindy Simmons, who is the PR rep for Weim Rescue of SC and several rescue volunteers made a great showing at Columbia's "Bark To The Park" last month and raised \$86 in donations. On May 21, Petsmart, West Ashley, has offered to host Weimaraner Rescue Day and we will bring our rescue dogs there to meet the public, hand out adoption applications and foster home applications. We have about 9 dogs in foster homes available for adoption.

Southern Futurity/Maturity & WCA Specialty - Elena Lamberson

Things are going as well as can be expected. Judge is still reported to be ill but as of today, says he is judging the Fut/Mat. We passed around the trophy donation sheet and had several additions. Elena cannot attend this event and Janet Boggs has agreed to be the show chairman. Elena will do as much paperwork as possible including proofing the premium list and working with WCA & Greenville clubs.

New Business - Billie Nagorniak reported that she and Robin Clow have assembled a Raffle Basket from SC with lots of nice stuff in it to represent our club. Mary Ann Hall will take it to the National specialty for the raffle.
